Background

André Brunel, the renowned producer in Châteauneuf-du-Pape of Les Cailloux has produced this wonderfully, juicy wine for us. This is a blend of 90% Grenache and 10% Carignan. 60% of the fruit is declassified Côtes-du-Rhône from vineyards in Travaillon, just east of Gigondas and northeast of Vacqueyras. All of the grapes are destemmed to allow the easy fruit to shine through. The wine is fermented and aged in tank to retain the freshness.

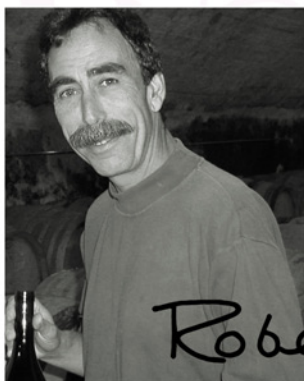
In the glass this wine is grapy and easy drinking with very primary notes of cherry and blackberry along side of cracked black pepper.
