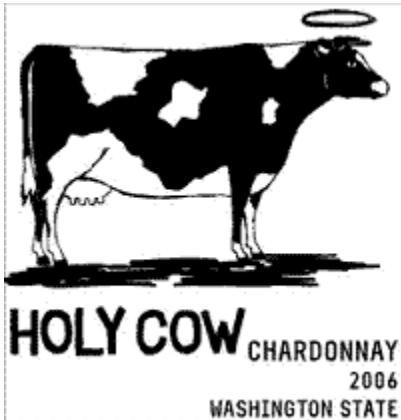

2007 Domaine de Pouy Cotes de Gascogne

White Wine; other white varietal; Other France;

Our dear friend 'Pouy' deserves a spot in the Spiritus Hall of Fame for all-time wine values, having seen us through many a year! Yves Grassa is a pioneer from Bas-Armagnac country who decided to try something new with the region's native colombar and ugni blanc grapes creating a crisp, dry white in addition to Gascogne's favorite after-dinner revelry, armagnac. The 2007 vintage is just as it should be- zippy and scintillating on the palate with enough character to serve as a cocktail wine and enough class and good manners to go well with dinner. Pouy has been one of the best values in crisp white wines for over two decades now. (Nate)
